

EMERGENCY EVACUATION PROCEDURE

In the event of an evacuation or discovering a fire.

1. Raise the Alarm- BLOW THE FIRE WHISTLE

The whistles are allocated in the **big room** hanging on the heating thermostat next to the arch way that leads into the conservatory **Toddler Room** hanging on the main door frame that leads into the hallway

Baby Room – By the back door Or you can listen for the smoke alarm.

- 2. **Immediately evacuate the building-** taking all children out of the nearest & safest fire exit
 - 3. Take all children to the named meeting point
 During practice sessions this will be the main garden along the
 fence, away from the building. In A Real Incident it would be at
 the church next door. If for any reason we were unable to
 get back into the nursery and the church is closed we will go
 over the road to the Moor Lane Centre (Big White building
 across the road, in front of the traffic lights)

The rooms named member of staff to collect a tablet Named fire warden to take contact cards, staff signing in and out book, nursery phone mobile and to check all rooms, close all doors behind them.
